- ON SERPENT SEED
- Gen.4:1-2 "And Adam KNEW Eve (ONCE) his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the Lord.
- And she again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground "

- ON THE SERPENT SEED
- 1 John.3:12 "Not as Cain, who was of that WICKED ONE, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his OWN WORKS (NATURE) WERE EVIL, and his BROTHER 'S RIGHTEOUS".

What happens after death?

- SAINTS GOES TO THEIR CELESTIAL BODY.
- 2 Corinthians.5:1-3 "For we know that if our earthly house were destroyed, we still have a building made by God, a house not made with hands, eternal life in heaven.
- We also weary over this earthly house, earnestly longing to use our house which is in heaven.
- If not so, even when we are clothed, we will still be naked.

What happens after death ?Saints goes to their celestial body

- 2 Corinthians.5:4-7 "While we are in this earthly house, we groan because of its weight: yet we are unwilling to leave it, but rather to add to it, so that death will be overcome by life.
- Now he who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who also has given to us pledge of his Spirit.
- Therefore we know and are convinced, that so long as we dwell in the body, we are absent from our LORD.
- For we walk by faith and not by sight.

What happens after death? Saints goes to their celestial body.

- 2 Corinthians.5:8-10 "This is why we are confident, and anxious to be absent from the body, and to be present with our LORD.
- Wherefore we endeavor, that, whether present or absent, we may be pleasing to him.
- For we must all stand before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may be rewarded according to that which he has done with his body, whether it be good or bad.

What happens after death? Saints goes to their celestial body.

- But some man will say, How are the dead raised up? And with what body do they come?
- Thou fool, that which thou sowest, thou sowest is not quickened, except it die:
- And that which thou sowest, thou sowest not body that shall be, bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or of some other grain:
- But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body. (1 CORINTHIANS.15:35-38)


What happen after death? Saints goes to their celestial body

- 1 Corinthians.15:40- 43. "There are also celestial bodies, bodies terrestrial: but the glory of the celestial is one, and the glory of the terrestrial is another.
- There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for one star differeth from another star in glory.
- So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:
- It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power.

What happen after death? Saints goes to their celestial body (house)

- In my Father's house (Kingdom) are many mansions (bodies): if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am there ye may be also. (JOHN.14:2-3)

Is Saturday or Sunday the correct day of worship?

- Every day on earth is MAN'S DAY. Saints can gather on any day. If a country's weekly DAY OF REST IS SATURDAY Then worship on SATURDAY as people could gather on their rest day. The Apostles went to the temple or synagogues on the SABBATH Because that's the day that they could meet and preach to the Jewish people who gathered themselves according to the law of MOSES.
- The Sabbath was created for the man, and not man for the sake of the Sabbath.(Mark.2:27)

- Crosses were originally designed as occult symbols to be worshipped both in ancient Babylon and Egypt.
- The instrument of death was the cross, originally designed by Semiramis in honor of Tammuz. It was originally shaped like a "T", but as time passed, it became more sophisticated.

- In the Roman Empire the victim was crucified on the cross, not only to punish for his crime, but it was also considered a sacrifice to their pagan gods
- The cross was never a Christian symbol.
 When the Bible speaks of the cross, it always refers to Christ's sacrifice for sin.
 Not the cross itself.

 The early Christians did not consider the cross on which Jesus died a virtuous symbol, but rather as "the accursed tree" a device of death and "shame" (Heb.12:2). They did not trust in an old rugged cross. Instead, their faith was in what was accomplished on the cross; and through this faith, they knew the full and complete forgiveness of sin. It was in this sense that the apostles preached about the cross and gloried in it (1 Cor.1:17-18). They never spoke cross as a piece of wood one might hang from a chain around his neck as a protector or charm.

 It was not until Christianity began to be Paganized (or, as some prefer, paganism was Christianized), that the cross image came to be thought of as a Christian symbol. It was in AD 431 that crosses in churches and chambers were introduced, while the use of crosses on steeples did not come until about AD 586. In the sixth century, the crucifix image was sanctioned by the church of Rome.

- If the cross is a Christian symbol, it cannot be correctly said that its origin was within Christianity, for in one form or another, it was a sacred symbol long before the Christian era and among many non Christian people.
- It originated among the Babylonians of ancient Chaldea, was used as a symbol of god Tammuz.

- The cross is recognized as one of the most important symbol of Roman Catholic church. It is displayed on top of roofs and towers. It is seen on alters, furnishings, and ecclesiastical garments. The floor plan of the majority of Catholic churches is laid out in the shape of the cross.
- When an infant is sprinkled, the priest makes the sign of the cross upon its forehead saying "Receive the sign of the cross upon thy forehead".

 During confirmation, the candidate is signed with the cross. On Ash Wednesday ashes are used to make a cross on the forehead. When Catholic enter the church building, they dip the forefinger of the right hand in "holy water", touch the forehead, chest, the left and right shoulder thus tracing the figure of the cross. During Mass , the priest makes the sign of the cross 16 times and blesses the alter with the cross sign 30 times.

 Protestant churches, for the most part, do not believe in making the sign of the cross with their fingers. Neither do they bow down before crosses or use them as objects of worship. They have recognized that these things are unscriptural and superstitious. But the use of the cross has been commonly retained on pulpits, and in various other ways as a form of decoration.

THE TRUE SIGN OF A CHRISTIAN IS THE MANIFESTATION OF LOVE OF CHRIST- AGAPE

In Revelation 2:13 who is Antipas and where did he die?

 A faithful Christian who died a martyr in Pergamos. Believed to be John's disciple and bishop of Pergamos. He was burnt alive a few years before John died in AD100.

In Revelation 2:10 what is the 10 day period referring to in the Ephesus Church Age?

 300 to 310 AD. Dioletan, the Emperor went on a killing spree.

Why did Moses lift up a snake in the wilderness and what is the significance?

- "If the Son of man be lifted up, I shall draw all men to Myself". (John.12:32)
- Sin is nailed to the cross. All who had sinned must lift up their head and look at the pole (cross) so that they would be healed. The snake is the symbol of Sin. On the pole it symbolizes Sin nailed. Christ is the Sin Offering lifted up.

JESUS descended to lower parts of the EARTH

- Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.
- Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended into lower parts of the Earth.
- He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all. (EPHESIANS.4:8-10)

JESUS descended first into lower parts of the EARTH

- Jesus when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost
- And behold the veil of the temple was rent twain from the top to the bottom; and the Earth did quake, and rocks rent;
- And the graves were opened and many bodies of the saints which slept arose,
- And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many. (MATTHEW.27:50-53)
